AAHE, NCHEC and SOPHE are pleased to collaboratively announce that the Final Report of the Competency Update Project (CUP) has been completed through the efforts of the CUP Steering Committee and Advisory Committee Members. Further information and an Executive Summary of the report will be available soon on the websites of each

organization. An undated competency-based framework for health educators based upon the outcome of the CUP study will be published and released in early 2005.

6. A ten-year Revision of the National Health Education Standards for grades k-12 has begun under the administration of AAHE and the sponsorship of the American Cancer Society. Collaborating organizations include the American School Health Association, the Society of State Directors of HPER, and the American Public Health Association.
